

Safe & Trusted AI/ML: Policies should focus on responsible governance and monitoring, ensuring AI tools are equitable and free from bias.

Clinician & Consumer Trust: Al tools must provide explainability and maintain fairness.

Feedback Loop: Regulatory frameworks should allow users to report AI performance issues.

Patient Privacy: AI/ML systems must protect patient data with clear privacy standards.

Interoperability: Standards should ensure AI/ML

technologies integrate seamlessly.

Workforce Development: Support for AI skill-building in healthcare professionals is crucial.
